SOUTH DAKOTA MILK PRODUCTION

SIOUX FALLS, SD, April 21, 2014 – Milk production in South Dakota during March 2014 totaled 174 million pounds, up two percent from March 2013, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 95,000 head. Milk production per cow averaged 1,830 pounds.
