SOUTH DAKOTA MILK PRODUCTION

SIOUX FALLS, SD, August 19, 2014 -- Milk production in South Dakota during July 2014 totaled 179 million pounds, up three percent from July 2013, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 97,000 head, 2,000 head more than July 2013. Milk production per cow averaged 1,845 pounds.
