SOUTH DAKOTA TURKEYS RAISED

SIOUX FALLS, SD, September 30, 2014 – **Turkeys raised** in South Dakota during 2014 is forecasted at 4.3 million birds unchanged from the previous year’s number, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service. Turkeys raised in the United States during 2014 is forecasted at 235 million, down 2 percent from the number raised during 2013.
