SOUTH DAKOTA MILK PRODUCTION

SIOUX FALLS, SD, April 21, 2015 -- Milk production in South Dakota during March 2015 totaled 194 million pounds, up 10 percent from March 2014, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 102,000 head, 6,000 head more than March 2014. Milk production per cow averaged 1,900 pounds.
