SOUTH DAKOTA CHICKEN AND EGGS

SIoux FALLS, SD, January 22, 2016 – All layers in South Dakota during December 2015 totaled 1.59 million, down from 2.65 million the previous year, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service.

South Dakota egg production during December totaled 37.0 million eggs, down from 68.0 million in 2014. December egg production per 100 layers was 2,329 eggs, compared to 2,564 eggs in 2014.
