## SOUTH DAKOTA JANUARY 1 CATTLE INVENTORY

**SIOUX FALLS, S.D. January 31, 2024 - All cattle and calves** in South Dakota as of January 1, 2024 totaled 3.45 million head, down 1% from January 1, 2023, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

All cows and heifers that had calved totaled 1.71 million head, down 1% from last year.

**Beef cows** totaled 1.50 million head, down 2% from last year.

Milk cows totaled 208,000 head, up 11% from January 1, 2023.

All heifers 500 pounds and over totaled 730,000 head, down 6% from last year.

Steers weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 690,000 head, unchanged from last year.

**Bulls** weighing 500 pounds and over totaled 100,000 head, unchanged from last year.

Calves under 500 pounds totaled 220,000 head, up 5% from January 1, 2023.

**All cattle on feed** fed for slaughter in South Dakota feedlots totaled 420,000 head, down 2% from the previous year.

The **2023 calf crop** totaled 1.65 million head, down 2% from 2022.
