SOUTH DAKOTA CATTLE ON FEED UP 2%

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. March 19, 2021 - South Dakota feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 245,000 cattle on feed on March 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 2% from last year.

Placements during February totaled 39,000 head, up 8% from 2020.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of February totaled 36,000 head, up 9% from last year.

Other disappearance during February totaled 3,000 head, unchanged from last year.
