SOUTH DAKOTA CHICKENS AND EGGS

SIoux FALLS, S.D. March 23, 2020 - All layers in South Dakota during February 2020 totaled 2.58 million, down from 2.79 million the previous year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

South Dakota egg production during February totaled 64.8 million eggs, up from 62.1 million in 2019. February egg production per 100 layers was 2,514 eggs, compared to 2,224 eggs in 2019.
