## SOUTH DAKOTA MILK PRODUCTION

**SIOUX FALLS, S.D. March 18, 2021** - Milk production in South Dakota during February 2021 totaled 251 million pounds, up 6% from February 2020, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 142,000 head, 13,000 head more than February 2020. Milk production per cow averaged 1,765 pounds.
