SOUTH DAKOTA TURKEYS RAISED

SIoux FALLS, S.D. September 29, 2017 - Turkeys raised in South Dakota during 2017 is forecasted at 4.10 million birds, down 2 percent from the previous year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Turkeys raised in the United States during 2017 is forecasted at 245 million, up slightly from the number raised during 2016.
