Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.35 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 14, down 4 percent from the week prior and down 5 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 13.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 14, down 11 percent from the week prior and down 4 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 14, was 4.57 million, up 12 percent from the previous week, and up 28 percent from the previous year.
