**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.67 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 23, down 1 percent from the week prior and up slightly from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 23, was 4.64 million, up 48 percent from the previous week, and up 11 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 23, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 23, was 12.8 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 7 percent from the previous year.
