Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.84 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 20, up 3 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 20, was 4.04 million, down 13 percent from the previous week, and up 6 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 14.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 20, down 1 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 20, was 12.6 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.
