Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.68 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 27, down 2 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 27, was 4.59 million, up 14 percent from the previous week, and up 4 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 27, up 4 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 27, was 12.5 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.
