Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.94 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 22, up 6 percent from the week prior and 4 percent above from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 22, was 4.28 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 5 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 14.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 22, down 4 percent from the week prior, but up 2 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 22, was 11.7 million, down 4 percent from the previous week and down 3 percent from the previous year.
