Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.16 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 3, down 10 percent from the week prior and 6 percent below from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 13.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 3, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 3, was 4.08 million, down 3 percent from the previous week, but up slightly from the previous year.

Chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 3, was 11.8 million, up 5 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
