Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.77 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 21, down 2 percent from the week prior, but 2 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 21, was 3.56 million, down 11 percent from the previous week and down 9 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 21, up 2 percent from the week prior and up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 21, was 12.0 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 2 percent from the previous year.
