**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.69 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 9, down 1 percent from the week prior, but 1 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 14.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 9, up slightly from the week prior, but down 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 9, was 5.22 million, up 4 percent from the previous week and up 25 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 9, was 12.2 million, down 3 percent from the previous week and down 1 percent from the previous year.
