**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.04 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 30, up 4 percent from the week prior and 10 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 30, up slightly from the week prior but down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 30, was 4.91 million, up 27 percent from the previous week and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 30, was 11.9 million, up 1 percent from the previous week but down 2 percent from the previous year.
