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Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.75 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 6, down 4 percent from the week prior but 6 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 6, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 6, was 4.74 million, down 4 percent from the previous week but up 21 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 6, was 12.3 million, up 4 percent from the previous week and up 3 percent from the previous year.
