**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.01 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 13, up 4 percent from the week prior and 6 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 13, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 13, was 3.93 million, down 17 percent from the previous week and down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 13, was 12.6 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.
