**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.64 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 12, down 1 percent from the week prior, but 5 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 12, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 12 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 12, was 3.29 million, down 25 percent from the previous week and down 29 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 12, was 13.0 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.
