Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.58 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 16, down 3 percent from the week prior and 1 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 16, down 1 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 16, was 4.69 million, up 16 percent from the previous week and up 28 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 16, was 12.7 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 2 percent from the previous year.
