Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.75 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 23, up 3 percent from the week prior and 10 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 23, was 4.59 million, down 2 percent from the previous week, but up 3 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 23, slightly below the week prior, but up 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 23, was 12.9 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 1 percent from the previous year.
