Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.83 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 14, up 4 percent from the week prior and 2 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 14, was 4.21 million, down slightly from the previous week but up 33 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 14, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 14, was 13.0 million, up 3 percent from the previous week and up 4 percent from the previous year.
