**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.03 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 25, up 1 percent from the week prior and 5 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 25, up 1 percent from the week prior, but down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 25, was 4.10 million, down 6 percent from the previous week and down 11 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 25, was 13.0 million, down slightly from the previous week, but up 4 percent from the previous year.
