**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.31 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 13, up 1 percent from the week prior and 11 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending August 13, up 3 percent from the week prior and up 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 13, was 4.76 million, up 23 percent from the previous week and up 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of August 13, was 12.8 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 6 percent from the previous year.
