**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 6.99 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 22, down 5 percent from the week prior but 4 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 22, down 1 percent from the week prior but up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 22, was 3.64 million, down 21 percent from the previous week and down 29 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 22, was 12.7 million, down 1 percent from the previous week but up 13 percent from the previous year.
