**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.67 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 5, down 1 percent from the week prior but 14 percent above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 15.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 5, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 9 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 5, was 3.39 million, down 6 percent from the previous week and down 18 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 5, was 12.7 million, up 3 percent from the previous week and up 13 percent from the previous year.
