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This report contains the results from the June 2016 Hog and Pig Survey. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas producers are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available September 30, 2016.

Oklahoma Highlights

The June 1, 2016 Oklahoma hog and pig inventory, at 2.15 million head, was 4 percent lower than June 2015. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 470 thousand head, up 30 thousand from last year. The June 1 **market hog** inventory was down 6 percent from a year ago at 1.68 million head, 78 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.


The March 2016-May 2016 Oklahoma **pig crop** totaled 2.01 million head, slightly below last year. Pigs per litter averaged 10.3, down slightly from the previous year. Sows farrowed during March 2016 through May 2016 totaled 195 thousand head, unchanged from last year.

Texas Highlights

The June 1, 2016 Texas hog and pig inventory, at 870 thousand head, was 1 percent lower than June 2015. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 100 thousand head, down 5 thousand from last year. The June 1 **market hog** inventory was down 1 percent from a year ago at 770 thousand head, 89 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.

The March 2016-May 2016 Texas **pig crop** totaled 345 thousand head, 27 percent below last year. Pigs per litter averaged 7.9, down 17 percent from the previous year. Sows farrowed during March 2016 through May 2016 totaled 44.0 thousand head, down 12 percent from last year.





U.S. Highlights

The U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs on June 1, 2016, is estimated at 68.4 million head, up 2 percent from a year ago and up 1 percent from March 1, 2016. The **breeding hog inventory**, at 5.98 million head, was up 1 percent from last year but down slightly from the previous quarter. **Market hog** inventory, at 62.4 million head, was up 2 percent from last year and up 1 percent from last quarter.

The U.S. **pig crop** for March 2016-May 2016, at 30.3 million, was up 3 percent from 2015. U.S. producers intend to have 2.95 million sows farrow during the June 2016-August 2016 period, down 2 percent from the actual farrowings during the same period last year. Intended farrowings for September 2016-November 2016, at 2.90 million sows, are down 1 percent from the same quarter the year prior.
