**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.50 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 14, down 8 percent from the week prior and slightly below the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 16.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending July 14, down 5 percent from the week prior and down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 14, was 4.50 million, up 11 percent from the previous week and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of July 14, was 13.9 million, up 3 percent from the previous week and up 3 percent from the previous year.
