Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.51 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 1, down 2 percent from the week prior and 6 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 13.6 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 1, down 15 percent from the week prior and down 11 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 1, was 3.90 million, down 11 percent from the previous week and down 10 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 1, was 13.0 million, down 3 percent from the previous week and down 1 percent from the previous year.
