Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.48 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 15, up 10 percent from the week prior and 1 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending September 15, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 15, was 3.21 million, down 25 percent from the previous week and down 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of September 15, was 13.0 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 2 percent from the previous year.
