



Weekly Broiler Report

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Cooperating with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry and Texas Department of Agriculture

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Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.62 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 20, up 6 percent from the week prior and 5 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending October 20, up 4 percent from the week prior and up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 20, was 4.35 million, up 16 percent from the previous week, but down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of October 20, was 12.2 million, down 3 percent from the previous week and down 4 percent from the previous year.
