November 7, 2018

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Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.57 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 3, down 4 percent from the week prior, but 3 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 14.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending November 3, down 8 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 3, was 3.32 million, down 1 percent from the previous week and down 19 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of November 3, was 12.7 million, up 4 percent from the previous week, but down 2 percent from the previous year.
