Oklahoma hatcheries set 6.67 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 8, down 13 percent from the week prior and 8 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 8, down 8 percent from the week prior and down 1 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 8, was 4.76 million, up 8 percent from the previous week and up 48 percent from the previous year.


The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 8, was 13.0 million, down slightly from the previous week and down 3 percent from the previous year.
