

The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of March. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas operators are the foundation of the estimates for the Southern Plains region. Separate surveys are conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. We would like to thank all operators who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available on June 29, 2018.

Oklahoma stocks of wheat in all positions on March 1 totaled 123 million bushels, were up 12 percent from the 2017 level of 109 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 119 million bushels were 12 percent higher than March 1, 2017.

Texas stocks of wheat in all positions on March 1, at 85.2 million bushels, were up 6 percent from the 2017 level of 80.6 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 83.9 million bushels were 6 percent higher than March 1, 2017.


Quarterly Wheat Stocks

Texas off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 22.2 million bushels, down 18 percent from last year. On-farm stocks totaled 800 thousand bushels on March 1, 2018.

Texas off-farm corn stocks, at 82.4 million bushels, were down 8 percent from last year. On-farm stocks are not published for the state.


**Texas Quarterly Stocks

Oklahoma off-farm sorghum stocks totaled 5.44 million bushels, down 6 percent March 1, 2017. On-farm stocks are not published for the state.

Oklahoma off-farm corn stocks, at 11.6 million bushels, were up 56 percent from a year earlier. On-farm stocks are not published for the state.



U.S. Highlights: Total stocks of corn in the United States on March 1, 2018 were 8.89 billion bushels, 3 percent higher than March 1, 2017. All wheat stocks were estimated at 1.49 billion bushels in all positions, down 10 percent from last March. U.S. stocks of sorghum totaled 138 million bushels, 23 percent below March 1, 2017. Stocks of soybeans in all positions totaled 2.11 billion bushels, up 21 percent from March 1, 2017.
