Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.60 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 30, down 1 percent from the week prior and 3 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 15.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 30, down 7 percent from the week prior and down 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 30, was 4.37 million, down 19 percent from the previous week but up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of December 30, was 12.6 million, down 7 percent from the previous week and down 3 percent from the previous year.
