Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.55 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 13, down 2 percent from the week prior and 1 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 16.0 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 13, up 2 percent from the week prior but down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 13, was 4.26 million, up 52 percent from the previous week but down 21 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 13, was 13.2 million, down 2 percent from the previous week, but up 3 percent from the previous year.
