**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.97 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 20, up 6 percent from the week prior and 3 percent above the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 20, was 3.76 million, down 12 percent from the previous week, but up 2 percent from the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 16.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 20, down slightly from the week prior, but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of January 20, was 12.2 million, down 7 percent from the previous week and down 5 percent from the previous year.
