

The grain stocks estimates are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of December. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas operators are the foundation of the estimates for the Southern Plains region. Separate surveys are conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. We would like to thank all operators who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available on March 29, 2018.

Oklahoma stocks of wheat in all positions on December 1, at 144 million bushels, were up 5 percent from the 2016 level of 137 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 140 million bushels were 7 percent higher than December 1, 2016.


Texas stocks of wheat in all positions on December 1, at 105 million bushels, were up 8 percent from the 2016 level of 97.4 million bushels. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 103 million bushels were 8 percent higher than December 1, 2016.

Texas sorghum stocks in all positions on December 1 totaled 31.0 million bushels, down 27 percent from the previous year. Off-farm sorghum stocks, at 28.1 million bushels, were 29 percent below December 1, 2016. **Texas** off-farm corn stocks on December 2017, at 124 million bushels, were down 10 percent from a year earlier. On-farm stocks are not published for Texas.


**Texas Quarterly Stocks

Oklahoma off-farm sorghum stocks, at 7.21 million bushels, were 13 percent below December 1, 2016. On-farm stocks are not published for the state.

Oklahoma off-farm corn stocks on December 2017, at 12.2 million bushels, were down 3 percent from a year earlier. On-farm stocks are not published for Oklahoma.

U.S. Highlights: Total stocks of corn in the United States on December 1, 2017 were 12.5 billion bushels, 1 percent higher than December 1, 2016. All wheat stocks were estimated at 1.87 billion bushels in all positions, down 10 percent from last December. U.S. stocks of sorghum totaled 226 million bushels, 27 percent below December 1, 2016. Stocks of soybeans in all positions totaled 3.16 billion bushels, up 9 percent from last year.
