Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.70 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 9, down 1 percent from the week prior and 2 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 16.8 million eggs in incubators during the week ending February 9, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 2 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 9, was 4.66 million, up 25 percent from the previous week and up 27 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of February 9, was 13.6 million, up 4 percent from the previous week and up 5 percent from the previous year.
