Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.46 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 2, down 3 percent from the week prior and slightly below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 2, down slightly from the week prior, but up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 2, was 3.62 million, down 22 percent from the previous week, but up 10 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 2, was 13.6 million, down slightly from the previous week, but up 1 percent from the previous year.
