**Oklahoma** hatcheries set 7.59 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 9, up 1 percent from the week prior and slightly above the previous year.

**Texas** hatcheries set 17.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 9, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 9, was 3.73 million, up 14 percent from the previous week, but down 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 9, was 13.9 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 6 percent from the previous year.
