Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.64 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 23, down 3 percent from the week prior, but 4 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.2 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 23, down 1 percent from the week prior, but up 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 23, was 4.57 million, up 29 percent from the previous week, but down 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 23, was 13.8 million, up slightly from the previous week and up 6 percent from the previous year.
