Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.70 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 30, up 1 percent from the week prior and 6 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending March 30, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 8 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 30, was 3.99 million, down 13 percent from the previous week, but up 5 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of March 30, was 13.8 million, down slightly from the previous week, but up 5 percent from the previous year.
