Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.73 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 20, down 1 percent from the week prior and slightly below the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 20, was 3.48 million, down 15 percent from the previous week and down 12 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.3 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 20, down slightly from the week prior, but up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 20, was 14.1 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up 4 percent from the previous year.
