Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.56 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 4, down 5 percent from the week prior and 3 percent below the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.9 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 4, up 1 percent from the week prior and up 10 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 4, was 5.54 million, up 25 percent from the previous week and up 60 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 4, was 14.1 million, down slightly from the previous week, but up 7 percent from the previous year.
