Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.83 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 11, up 4 percent from the week prior and 3 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.5 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 11, down 2 percent from the week prior, but up 7 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 11, was 3.41 million, down 39 percent from the previous week and down 39 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 11, was 14.1 million, down 1 percent from the previous week, but up 5 percent from the previous year.
