Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.93 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 18, down slightly from the week prior, but 2 percent above the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 17.4 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 18, down slightly from the week prior, but up 6 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 18, was 4.89 million, up 29 percent from the previous week, but down 3 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of May 18, was 14.6 million, up 3 percent from the previous week and up 7 percent from the previous year.
